They give you a survey of the city's history from its beginnings up to the present. You will find information about the founding of the city, the rule of the Anabaptists, the Thirty Years' War with the Peace of Westphalia, and the time of the Second World War. The guide offers interactive applications for children and is also informative for adults.

The loan of the multimedia guide is free of charge for children up to 12 years of age in return for a deposit. Adults can obtain the guide for a deposit and a loan charge of \leq 2 (reduced rate \leq 1). If required, hearing loops are also available.

The City Museum of Münster

In the permanent exhibition the City Museum features the history of the city of Münster from its beginnings up to the present. Special exhibitions are dedicated to particular aspects of the history of Münster's art and culture.

The museum is situated in the pedestrian area in the city centre (five minutes walk from the train station). Open Tuesday — Friday 10:00 am — 6:00 pm, Saturday, Sunday and on public holidays 11:00 am — 6:00 pm, except Mondays. Special opening hours for holidays will be announced in advance. The museum is accessible for wheelchair users. **Admission free!**
